The Kathleen Ferrier Society was established in 1993 to mark the 40th Anniversary of her death. The remarkable strength of interest in one of the greatest British singers of the Twentieth Century was soon evident and we now have about 200 members spread across the world.

The main aims of the Society are:

- ◆ To provide a focal point and information service.
- ◆ To award an annual £3,000 Bursary to aspiring young singers, to assist with their musical studies. At the end of October each year in King George's Hall, Blackburn, 16 students represent their Music Colleges in the KFS Bursary for Young Singers Competition.
- ◆ To support Cancer Research through donations to the UCL Kathleen Ferrier Fund for Cancer Research.
- ◆ To provide an education, Archive and Research Facility for documents, recordings and memorabilia, and to promote original research. Most of the memorabilia collected since 1953 is now housed in Blackburn Museum.
- ◆ To arrange Recitals/Exhibitions/Celebrations/Society Weekends.
- ◆ To produce Newsletters for members.
